Mary Louise Thomas of Chester, MD, died at the Shore Nursing & Rehabilitation Center on Thursday, January 6, 2000. She was 82 years old.

Born on May 28, 1917, the daughter of the late James and Manie Lewis Dadds. Mrs. Thomas was a graduate of the Tri-County High School in Queen Anne, MD. Mrs. Thomas lived in Hillsboro, MD, until 1971 with her husband, Joseph Thompson Thomas of Kent Island, who predeceased her. She then moved to Kent Island where she was a homemaker and caregiver to the chronically ill. Mrs. Thomas was a member of the St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Hillsboro, MD, and also a member of the Women of the Moose, Easton Chapter.

Mrs. Mary Thomas is survived by a son, James Warren Thomas of Hillsboro, MD; a daughter, Mary Jo Connell of Stevensville, MD.; and two brothers, Winfield Pinder and Bernard Pinder who both predeceased her.
