Mary Mangus (Mary Lou Hutchison) passed away on Monday, January 13, 2025, at her home in New Haven, CT. She was born in Easton Maryland, the daughter of Ray and Anna Mae Hutchison of Queen Anne. She was predeceased by her parents and sister Joan Reed Flowers. Mary is survived by her husband, John Mangus, son John Daniel Mangus, his wife Ginny and 6 grandchildren, Sister Lois Hutchison DeRosa (Nick) of Lancaster, PA and two nephews Evan Todd (Isabel), Philadelphia and Chuck Reed (Mary) of Kinston, NC.

Mary was a member of the Hillsboro United Methodist Church where she sang in the choir and accompanied on piano and organ. She graduated Queen Anne's County High School with high honors as Valedictorian, co-editor of the Yearbook, recipient of the Book Award, served as Constitutional Page as nominated by the school principal to the Maryland Constitutional Convention. She was awarded the Teacher's Education scholarship and graduated from Western Maryland College (McDaniel College) with a degree in Sociology. Mary studied piano under Mrs. Wolcott in Centreville and was a gifted pianist accompanying music and choral programs in middle school and under Miss Angie West in High School.

Mary was employed by the Gesell Institute of the Yale Child Study Program in New Haven, CT and as the assistant to the director of Goodwill Industries in Bridgeport, CT.

Mary was a beloved daughter, sister, aunt, cousin, and friend remembered for

her sweet personality, strong faith, humor, intelligence and musical ability. She always helped those less fortunate than herself. A bookworm, Mary Lou was always kind and gentle, with a strong social justice view. We have wonderful memories of birthday parties and trips to Conquest Beach with her many friends, cousins and neighbors.

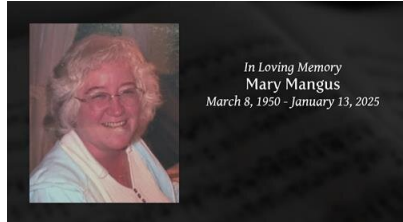
