Mary Josephine May died on March 31, 2013, at The Heartfields at Easton, MD. She was 91 years of age.

Born in Chuquicamata, Chile, she was the daughter of the late Ovid B. Hundley and the late Josie Mae Griswold Hundley. She lived in Santiago, Chile, during her early years and attended Santiago College. She graduated in 1943 with B.A. degree from the College of William and Mary in Williamsburg, VA.

Mary Jo was as a homemaker and involved in a number of organizations in various parts of the world. She was particularly active in Cub Scouting. Along with her husband and family, she lived in Hawaii, Japan, England, Germany, Canada, and Belgium before moving to the United States where they resided in Upper Saddle River, NJ, and later Queenstown, MD. In 1996, the Mays moved to the Londonderry Retirement Community, followed by Heart Fields, both of Easton.

Mary Jo and Frank enjoyed many years of sailing and boating. Mary Jo was an active member of the Poplar Island Yacht Club as well as the T-4-C Club and the Half Miles Auxiliary of the Miles River Sail and Power Squadron.

She is survived by her husband of 71 years, Frank B. May; her three sons,
