Mary "Mikki" Obenschain passed away from Leukemia on Sunday, November 26, 2023, at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton, MD. She was 76 years old. Mikki was born on September 16, 1947, to Arthur and Mary Obenschain in Washington, D.C. Mikki was the youngest of three children, with two older brothers Rick and Chuck. She grew up in Hillandale, MD and attended Springbrook High School. Mikki graduated from The University of Maryland in 1969 with a degree in Biology.

She worked at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Maryland and lived in Atlanta Georgia before moving back to Maryland.
