December 3, 1930 - October 7, 2020

Mary Angela Rossi of Queenstown, MD Died at Anne Arundel Medical Center on October 7, 2020. She was 89 years old.

Born on December 3, 1930 in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late Vincent C. and Margaret Schlepner Kirby. She graduated from St. Patrick's School where she learned shorthand and typing. On March 6, 1947 she married Mario Vincent Rossi of Govens part of Baltimore. They made their home in Curtis Bay, Pasadena, then Catonsville and then in December of 1995 they moved to Queenstown, MD. Mrs. Rossi worked as a Fiscal Associate for the State of Maryland in the dept. of Human Resources. She retired from the State of Maryland in 1989.
