Mary Louise "Sis" Parker, 78, of Centreville, MD, passed away on October 29, 2020, at her home after a short illness. She was born on November 16, 1941, in Rock Hall, the daughter of the late Howard "Peck" and Hazel Clothier Happersett.

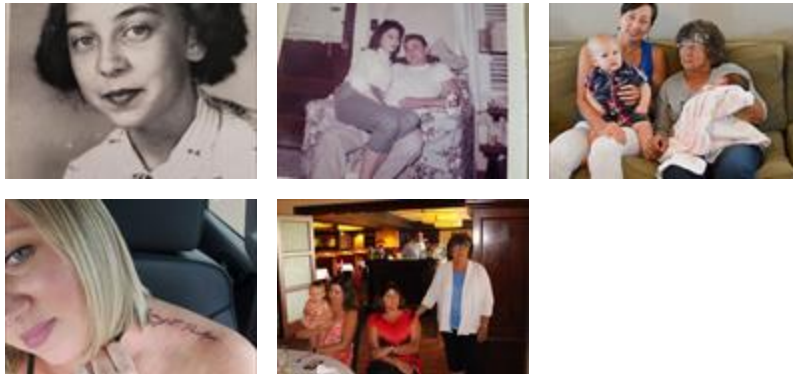
