December 24, 1922 - September 30, 2015

Mary Spencer Smith of Easton, MD, died on Wednesday, September 30, 2015, at HeartFields at Easton. She was 92.

She was born at home in Doncaster in Easton on December 24, 1922, and was the fifth living child of the late Joseph Spencer and Laura Mullikin Spencer. She graduated from St. Michaels High School. She worked as a Chief Telephone Operator for the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company before becoming a homemaker. In 1950, she married her lifelong dance partner, Jimmy Smith, who died in 2003. She raised her family in Old Bloomfield and later moved to North Bend to live with her daughter. Mrs. Smith was a founding member of the United Methodist Church of Easton. She was an avid vegetable gardener and bird watcher.

Mrs. Smith is survived by two daughters, Laurie Gaffney and Jenny Kade; son-in-law Fritz Kade; and three grandchildren, Evan Gaffney (Amanda) of CO; Charlie Kade of Manhattan, KS; and Laura Kade (Aliaksei Patsevich) of Dallas, TX.

She also leaves behind her loyal companion, Shanta Banks. Last year, she moved to HeartFields and was lovingly cared for by the wonderful care managers, and she enjoyed being with the other residents.
