



Mary Fahey Steinberger

October 6, 1931 - July 6, 2013

Mary Fahey Steinberger of Claiborne, MD, died on July 6, 2013, at the Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 81.

Born on October 6, 1931, in Newark, NJ, she was the daughter of the late Edward and M. Isabelle Fahey.

She graduated in 1949 from the Benedictine Academy in Elizabeth, NJ. In 1953, she graduated from the Georgian Court College in Lakewood, NJ. Then in 1968 she received her Masters Degree in Library Science from Rutgers University in New Brunswick, NJ.

On September 29, 1956, she married Ralph Steinberger in Spring Lake, NJ. They moved to Tinton Falls, NJ, in 1960 and resided there with her family until moving to Claiborne, MD, in 1989. Mrs. Steinberger spent her career as a librarian; at Holy Innocents School in Neptune, NJ, and at Brookdale Community College in Lincroft, NJ.

She was an active member of the Saint Michaels Chapel of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church, the Saint Anne & Joachim Society, the Saint Michaels Bible Study Group, the American Association of University Women, and Friends of the Saint Michael's Library.

Mrs. Steinberger is survived by her loving husband of 57 years, Ralph; her children, Ann, Michael and wife Michelle, Karen and husband John Steiner, James and wife Holly, Timothy and partner Kathy; a brother, Vincent Fahey of Neptune, NJ; eleven grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren. Along with her parents, she was predeceased by a brother, Edward Fahey, Jr., and her sister, Agnes Fahey.

Friends may call on Tuesday, July 9, 2013, from 6-8 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton. A Funeral Liturgy celebrating Mary's life will be held on Wednesday, July 10, 2013, at 10 a.m. at Saint Michaels Chapel, St. Michaels, MD. Burial will be private. Mrs. Steinberger had one request-- for her friends and family not to be dressed in black and celebrate of her wonderful life.

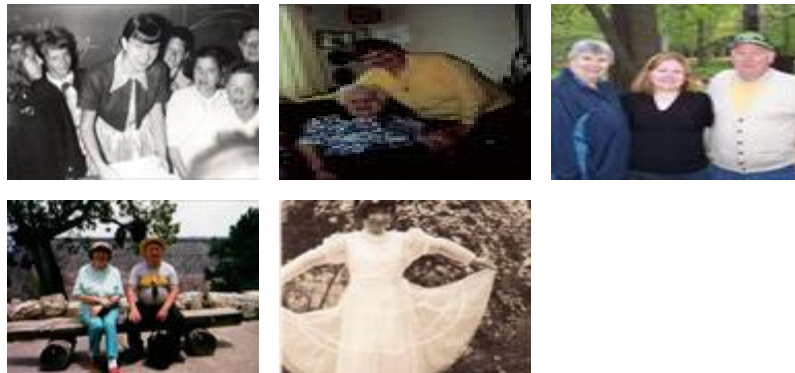
