June 1, 1940 - October 31, 2019

Mary Ann Holden Taylor of Chestertown, MD, died on Thursday, October 31, 2019, at her home. She was 79.

Born on June 1, 1940 in Millington, MD, she was the daughter of the late Wilford Thomas and Bertha Dora Taylor Holden. She was married to Edward Ellis Mann, who predeceased her in 1960. She later remarried to Charles F. Taylor on May 4, 1962. They were married for 37 years.

Mrs. Taylor worked with Rock Hall shirt factory and the tomato cannery. She spent the bulk of her career as a school bus driver for Kent County Public Schools until her retirement in 2010. 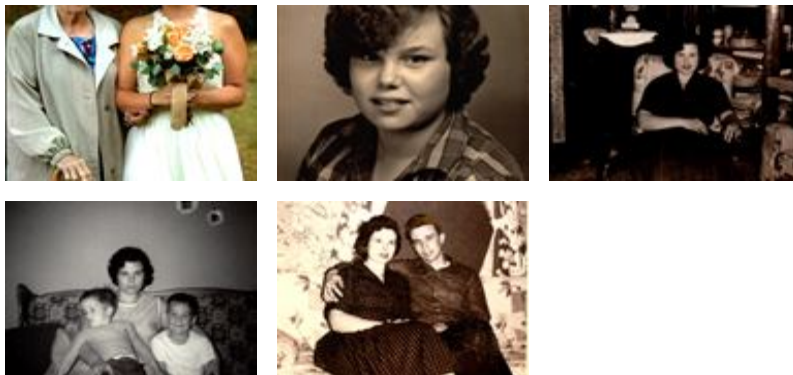
