Mary “Paige” Taylor, of Centreville, passed away peacefully on January 31, 2026, at Compass Regional Hospice House.

Born on November 8, 1956, in Washington, Paige was adopted before her first birthday by William Bruce Taylor and Mary Janet Taylor. She was raised in the Chartwell community of Severna Park and graduated from Severna Park High School with the Class of 1974.

Paige dedicated more than 15 years to the tax department of the Maryland Comptroller's Office. After her career with the state, she found her place in the hospitality industry, helping manage Murphy's Pub—later known as Corsica's Lighthouse Pub—for nearly a decade. She later worked at the Bay Country Moose Lodge #831, where she was also a proud member and served in several officer roles.

She made Centreville her home after moving there with her former husband, Daniel “Danny” Anderson (1955–2014). Paige enjoyed the simple pleasures in life: walking through town, riding motorcycles with friends, spending time with those she loved, and snuggling with her cats. She was a loyal fan of the Philadelphia Eagles and the Baltimore Orioles and rarely missed the chance to cheer them on.

Paige is survived by her daughter, Rachel Hinton (Mike Henderson); her son, Joshua Anderson; her cherished grandson, Wyatt Henderson; and her brother, William S. "Chip" Taylor (Anita).
