Mary Ellen Jacobs Thompson of Rock Hall, MD died on July 15, 2024, at Rock of Ages Assisted Living in Rock Hall, MD. She was 96.

She was born in Rock Hall, MD on September 26, 1927, the daughter of the late G. Maxwell and Mary Smith Jacobs. She was a graduate of Rock Hall High School Class of 1944. She was married to the late Paul J. Thompson who predeceased her in January of 2004.

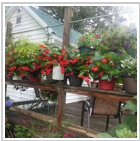
