Mary Eleanor Walls of Centreville, MD, died at Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD, on Saturday, June 12, 2010. She was 87.

Born August 31, 1922, in Lynch, MD, she was the daughter of the late, Robert and Florence Keyser Usilton. She grew up in Lynch and graduated from Chestertown High School. 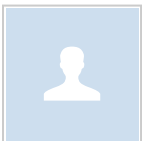
