



## Mary Sullivan Woodson

January 25, 1923 - June 14, 2013

Mary Ellen Sullivan Woodson of Easton, MD, died Friday, June 14, 2013, at Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 90.

Mrs. Woodson was born January 25, 1923, in Walkersville, MD, to the late Frank Grimes and Maude Green Grimes. She graduated from Walkersville High School and worked as a beautician in New York City. In 1945, she married Lt. JG Brinton E. Sullivan, USN, and moved to Washington for a short time, where their son, Roll, was born. The family moved back to Maryland in the 1950s where Mrs. Woodson and her husband owned and operated Sullivan's Antiques in New Market, MD, for more than 30 years. Shortly after her husband's passing in 1983, she moved to Easton, MD.

In 1999, she married Pendleton Woodson, and the couple resided in Easton, MD. Mr. Woodson died in October 2011.

Mrs. Woodson is survived by her son, Roll A. Sullivan and his wife Mary Beth of Easton; four grandchildren, Jennifer Sullivan Brych, Sarah Sullivan Wheedleton, Matthew Sullivan and Mary Katherine Sullivan Thomas; and five great-grandchildren, Mia Isabelle Wheedleton, Cooper Jaroslav Brych, Clara Anna Wheedleton, and two to be born in the fall.

A private funeral service was held June 16, 2013. A private interment will be

held at a later date in Culpeper National Cemetery in Culpeper, VA.
