Mary Margaret Harper Young died on November 26, 2016, at Chesapeake Woods in Cambridge, MD. She was 80.

Known as Cissy to her family, she was born February 13, 1936, at home in St. Michaels. She was the daughter of Ethel Harper Marshall and Harry Positera. As a young girl, she was raised in St. Michaels and graduated from St. Michaels High School in 1954, where she was on the basketball team and participated in after school clubs.

During her lifetime, she worked at Noble Ford in Easton where she met her first husband, Joseph W. Everngam, Sr. She was also employed at Yale Sportswear, Waverly Press, and the MVA, retiring in 2006 after 20 years of service. Cissy lived most of her life in Easton and in May of 2015, moved from St. Mark's Village to Chesapeake Woods in Cambridge, due to a decline in her health.

On December 31, 1975, she married Phillip A. "Skip" Young, who passed away November 20, 2005. They would have celebrated 30 years of marriage that December 31.

An avid collector of carousel horses and porcelain dolls, she also enjoyed visiting family in Pennsylvania, playing bingo, attending local festivals to listen

to music, and joining her friends at the Amish Market, American Legion, and VFW.
