Mary Anne (Nucho) Fisher of Rock Hall, Maryland died on August 11, 2006 at her home in Rock Hall, MD. She was 78.

Born in Chester, Pennsylvania on August 19, 1927, she was the daughter of the late Saleh and Najla Khoury Nucho.

She was a graduate of Ridley Park High School in Ridley Park, PA and attended college at West Chester University. On April 3, 1948 she married Robert Fisher, Sr.; they resided in Ridley Park, PA. Mrs. Fisher worked as a caseworker for Social Services with the State of Pennsylvania until she retired in 1988. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church in Ridley Park and worked with Pennsylvania Military College (now Widner University) where she was a house mother for the military drill team. She was also very involved with the Ridley Park Boy's Club Drill Team and in 1974 served as a Girl Scout leader. Mrs. Fisher and her husband were involved with Ridley Park Barnstormers Theatre Group. Upon her retirement in 1988 she moved to Rock Hall, Maryland where she and her husband owned a summer home since 1953.

An avid traveler, Mrs. Fisher was active with the Elkhart travelers Association and served as secretary and treasurer with the Woodchuck Chapter of the F.C.R.V. Camping Club. In addition to camping she enjoyed cooking for the

Rock Hall Lions Club and watching her grandchildren play sports.

In addition to her husband she is survived by three children: Sandra Coleman and her husband J. Robert of Rock Hall, Maryland, Robert Fisher, Jr. and his wife Elena of Rock Hall, MD, and Andrew Fisher of Ebensburg, PA, a brother: Sammy Nucho of Ridley Park, PA, seven grandchildren: Kouri Miller, Jamie Coleman, Kelly Coleman, Bobby Fisher, Danny Fisher, Travis Fisher, and Renee Fisher, and two great grandchildren: Grant Miller and Lauren Miller.
