



## Mary Bishop Keith Jukes

Mary Bishop Keith Jukes, of William Hill Manor in Easton, passed away on Monday, December 12, 2005. She was 95.

Born October 23, 1910 near Centreville, she was the eldest of five children born to John William (Will) and Elva Bishop Keith. After graduating from Centreville High School she worked for the local bank. On June 7, 1941, she married James Herbert Fielding Jukes, and the couple moved to the Washington area. They lived in Bethesda for more than 40 years before retiring to Easton in 1986. Mr. Jukes died October 25, 1991.

Mrs. Jukes was an active volunteer, serving others in schools, scouting, and through her church. She was a gracious and social lady who took delight in being with family and friends.

Survivors dear to her include her daughter, Mary Jukes Howard and her husband, Wilmont Howard of Addison, TX; her grandchildren Sara Howard Sarcione and Zachary Howard, both of whom live in the Boston area; a sister-in-law, Molly T. Keith of Kensington; and eleven nieces and nephews, their children and grandchildren.
