Mary Capel Blunt of Centreville, MD died at the Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville on Sunday, November 30, 2003. She was 78.

Born January 4, 1925 in Centreville, MD, she was the daughter of the late William Thomas and Bertha Rebecca Jackson Capel. She was a graduate of Centreville High School in 1943. She then went to work for the Queen Anne's County Board of Education for several years. She married Wilmer Olin Blunt on March 20, 1952 and they farmed together until retirement in 1972. Mr. Blunt died January 5, 2000 following a long battle with Alzheimer's.

They were past members of the Farm Bureau.

Mrs. Blunt is survived by a daughter, Linda V. Johnson of Centreville; two grandchildren, Chad W. Stanley of Centreville and Heather R. Stanley of Millington; three great grandchildren, Elizabeth Newsome and Kelsey Newsome and Zachary W. Stanley; one sister-in-law, Jane Blunt Clemmens of Towson. A sister and brother-in-law, Sarah Capel Blunt and Samuel W. Blunt and a brother, William Capel are deceased.
