



## Mary C. Coyle

November 22, 1916 - October 25, 2008

Mary Cowenhoven Coyle of Chestertown, Maryland died on October 25, 2008 at Heron Point in Chestertown. She was 91.

She was born on November 22, 1916 in New Brunswick, NJ the daughter of the late Charles T. Jr. and Emily (Rodgers) Cowenhoven. She was the wife of the late Dan D. Coyle.

Mrs. Coyle attended Miss Fines School in Princeton and graduated from Miss Porters School in Farmington, CT. She was employed by Town Topics, a weekly Princeton newspaper founded by her husband along with her brother in law, Donald Stuart.

She was a long time resident of Princeton, New Jersey where she spent her childhood and most of her married life. In 1973 she and her husband retired to the house built by her father –in – law on Lands End Road in Church Hill, Maryland. In 2000 she took up residence with her sister, and only surviving sibling, Margaretta Cowenhoven at Heron Point in Chestertown.

A devoted mother, grandmother, and sister: in addition to her sister she is survived by two daughters: Georgiana Evans of Ft. Lee, NJ and Church Hill, MD, and Margaretta Kildebeck of San Francisco, CA and Church Hill, MD, three grandchildren, Michael, Patrick, and Molly along with four step grandchildren, four great grandchildren, and three step great grandchildren. She was a member of St. Luke's Parish in Church Hill, MD and the Chester River Association.
