Mary Catherine Stevens of Chester died on December 19, 2001 at the Skilled Nursing Facility of the Easton Memorial Hospital after a long illness. She was 84.

Born on September 22, 1917, she was the daughter of the late E. Frank Lewis and Arie Thompson Lewis, and step-daughter of Ella Coleman Lewis. During WWII, Mrs. Stevens worked at the Defense Plant in Chestertown. She also worked in the concession stand on the Chesapeake Bay Ferries. Mrs. Stevens was a member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church. On September 28, 1948, she married William Seaford Stevens, who is now a resident of The Heartland House in Grasonville.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Stevens is survived by a son, William Seaford Stevens, Jr. of Grasonville, and a daughter, Mary Ann Coursey, of Chestertown. She is also survived by four grandchildren, Amanda Stevens of Chester, Graham A. Coursey of Chestertown, and Jessica E. and William Cody Stevens, both of Grasonville; one great-grandchild, Dylan Crannell of Chester; a brother, William H. Lewis of Stevensville; a half-sister, Betty V. Wolf of Chester; and two half-brothers, Roger Lewis, of Easton and Joe Lewis of Grasonville. Two brothers, Ralph Lewis and Lemuel Edward Lewis, are deceased.

Services will be held 11:00AM on Friday, December 21, 2001 at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Chester, where family and friends may call one hour prior to the service. Burial will be at Stevensville Cemetery.
