Mary Chauvenet Goff “Grandma” of Queenstown, MD died on Friday, March 8, 2002 at Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 91.

Born on December 17, 1910 in New Hope, PA, she was the daughter of the late Charles Rosen and Mildred Holden. She attended school at Holmquist School for Girls, first as a day pupil and later as a boarder, but was unable to finish due to illness. The family would later move to Woodstock NY in 1920 where her father taught Art at the Art Students League Summer School and would later move to Columbus, Ohio in 1924. In the mid 1930’s she moved to Washington, D.C. to live with her sister and worked at the Canine Catering Company. In 1937 she married Richard Callaway Goff and was a homemaker and the family resided in the Annapolis area and in Woodstock, NY. Her husband predeceased her in 1970, at which time she would reside with her daughters in Queenstown, MD.

She is survived by two daughters, Holden Stone Goff of Queenstown, MD and Virginia Callaway Macchia of Chestertown, MD; six grandchildren, Timothy T. Jones, Holly C. Jones, Justin C. Jones, Matthew G. Jones, Kelly M. Platzke and Jonathan S. Goff and five great-grandchildren. A sister, Katherine Rosen Warner predeceased her.

A memorial service will be held 1PM on Saturday, March 23, 2002 at the
