



Mary Elizabeth Kennedy

August 30, 1920 - August 9, 2008

Mary Elizabeth Kennedy of Trappe, MD died at William Hill Gardens, Easton, MD on Saturday, August 9, 2008. She was 87.

Born in Talbot County, August 30, 1920, she was the daughter of the late John and Elizabeth Dyott Foster. A lifelong resident of Talbot County, she was a member of the Emmanuel Wesleyan Church in Trappe. She was a wonderful woman to all that knew her and was totally dedicated to her family. Her love for her family was her main goal and satisfaction in life. She spent many years as the wife of a farmer, milking dairy cows, driving grain trucks, raising ducks and geese, while providing three full-course meals for her family. She raised and nurtured family members as they lived off the land. She had a true bond with her entire family and as many as 60 members gathered with her to celebrate Thanksgiving Day.

Her husband, Thomas Lee Kennedy, Sr. whom she married September 19, 1937, died August 6, 1982.

Mrs. Kennedy is survived by seven children; Pearl E. Coughenour of Easton, Rosemary Greenwood and her husband Terry of Salisbury, Dottie Kennedy of Trappe, Tammy Miller and her husband Mark of Easton, Jerry Kennedy and his wife Cheryl of Sharptown, Robert "Bo" Kennedy and his wife Pam of Trappe and Pete Kennedy and his wife Laurie of Trappe; eighteen

grandchildren, sixteen great-grandchildren and four great-great grandchildren. Another son, Lee Kennedy, died October 31, 1976.
