Mary Hubbard Fish Aspinwall, 93, died May 15 at the hospital in Chestertown. She was the daughter of the late Captain and Mrs. Hubbard C. Fish of New York, and the widow of the late Lieutenant John E. Aspinwall of the 101st Airborne Division. She was born in Brooklyn, New York, but raised on Staten Island, and attended the Staten Island Academy, Curtis High School, N.Y. University, and the Drake Business School. She worked as an executive secretary for the Russell Sage Foundation, U.S. Trust Company, CPC International, and was secretary to the President of the American Bank Note Company until she retired in 1972. She then moved to Ridgefield, Connecticut, where she had time to pursue her interests in music, art, bridge, and reading.

She is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Lydia Ann and Joseph W. Wagner of Chestertown, two sisters-in-law, four nieces, three nephews, and three grandcats.
