STEVENSVILLE, MD: Mary Frances Jewell of Stevensville, MD died Wednesday, August 24, 2005 at her home. She was 91.

Born on July 25, 1914 on Kent Point in Stevensville, MD, the daughter of the late Lillian V. Carter and Marion N. Tanner. In 1932, Mrs. Jewell graduated from Stevensville High School where she was a member of the volley ball team that won the Maryland State Championship her senior year. In 1933, she married Charles Clarke Jewell of Grasonville, MD. They resided in Stevensville where they built and operated the Curfew II, a restaurant they ran on the family farm until WWII began. In the early 1950's, Mrs. Jewell began working for American Store which is now known as Acme Market. She retired from the meat department in 1979. Mrs. Jewell was a member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church, United Food and Commercial Workers Union Local 56 and past Den Mother of the Cub Scouts. She loved spending time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren and enjoyed helping people in times of need. Many will remember her for being charitable and her famous chicken pie.

Mrs. Jewell is survived by two sons, Charles C. Jewell of Chester, MD and Thomas C. "Bucky" Jewell of Chester, MD; twelve grandchildren, Pat Steiner
