Mary Joan Coleman of Union Bridge, died at the Pleasant View Nursing Home in Mt Airy on Monday, July 26, 2004. She was 69.

Born in St. Michaels, March 3, 1935, she was one of eleven children of the late Earl and Sarah Virginia Jefferson Haddaway. After attending public school, she, on April 11, 1952, married Carroll A. Coleman, a Talbot County carpenter. They made their home in the Trappe area until 1964 when they moved to the Odenton-Mt. Airy area. Here she worked for a number of years in patient care at a local nursing home. In 1994, they moved back to Bruceville near Trappe where she was a member of the Faith Chapel United Methodist Church. Her interests included cooking, sewing and flower gardening.

In 2001, they moved back to the Western Shore to make their home with their son, Kirk. Mr. Coleman died July 29, 2003.

Mrs. Coleman is survived by four sons, Carroll A. Coleman, Jr. and his wife, Lynn, of Hagerstown, Brooks R. Coleman and his wife, Dana, of Mt. Airy; Kirk D. Coleman and his wife, Karen, of Union Bridge and David L. Coleman and his wife, Rose, of Frederick; a sister, Margaret Simmons of Delaware; five brothers, William Haddaway of Florida, Joseph Haddaway of California, Kenneth Haddaway of St. Michaels, Robert E. Haddaway of Neavitt and Richard Haddaway, of Easton and eight grandchildren.
