



## Mary Lois Cockey

June 27, 1920 - December 20, 2009

Mary Lois Cockey passed away on Sunday, December 20, 2009 at her residence surrounded by her loving family. She was 89.

She was born on June 27, 1920 in Stevensville, MD to the late, Frank B. Cockey and Miriam Rosebud Stevens. In 1937 she graduated from Stevensville High School before attending Strayer Business School. Lois worked for the Social Security Administration and O.R. I. She married Thomas Baker Cockey on June 7, 1954 in Cuba. They raised their son in Silver Spring for 26 years. In 1989, Lois moved back to her beloved Eastern Shore and made her home.

She was an avid Washington Redskins fan and a season ticket holder for the Maryland Terps. In her later years, she discovered the pleasure of traveling, including places such as the Bahamas, Hawaii, Australia, and New Zealand. She was also an officer in the Kent Island Heritage Society.
