



## Mary Lou Hampp

October 19, 1922 - May 3, 2009

Mary Lou Hampp of Easton, MD died on Sunday, May 3, 2009 at Candlelight Cove in Easton. She was 86.

Born October 19, 1922 in El Dorado, AR, she was the daughter of the late, Cecil Brownie and Alice Edna Hornady Porter. After graduating from Myrtle Grove High School in El Dorado in 1939, she served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.
