



## Marylyn D. Ross

November 20, 1936 - December 28, 2023

Marylyn D. Ross of Chestertown, MD passed away on December 28, 2023. She was 87 years old.

She was born in Upper Darby, PA on November 20, 1936, the daughter of the late Mary and Archibald Dove. She grew up in Havertown, PA and graduated from Haverford High School with the class of 1955. She went on to become a licensed beautician and worked as a hair stylist. She met and married the love of her life, Charles Ross, on April 4, 1959. They had three beautiful children together whom they raised in Pennsylvania. In 1996, they moved to Kinnaird Point in Kent County, MD to enjoy their retirement together.

Among Marylyn's hobbies was sewing and she was talented at making clothes, cross stitch, needlepoint and loved anything "textiles". She was a member of the Red Hatters, and of the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown, MD and the United Presbyterian Church of Havertown, PA where she was a Trustee of the Church for many years. She will be remembered as a gentle, peaceful woman.

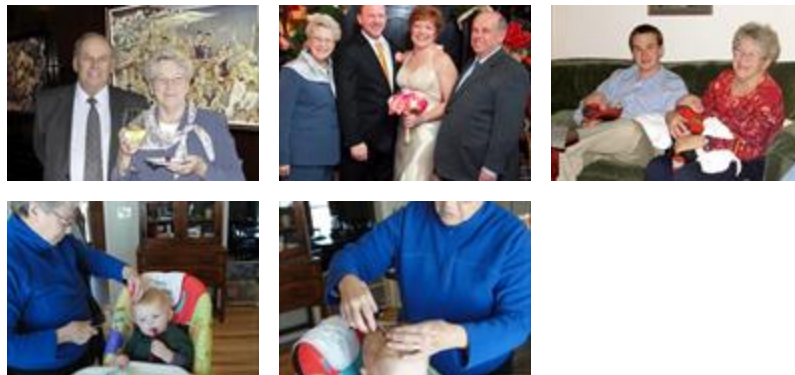

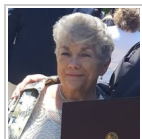
