Mary P. Coulby, of Easton, died at William Hill Gardens on Monday, April 4, 2011. She was 94.

Born in Baltimore on June 12, 1916, she was the daughter of the late Guy H. and Mary Ford Putman. The family moved to the Eastern Shore where she graduated from Easton High School in 1934. In June of 1934, she married Robert K. Coulby and they made their home in Easton where, from 1968 until 1978, she owned and operated Yeardeley Elder, Interior Design/Antiques.

A member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton, she was a member of the Memorial Hospital Auxiliary and the Talbot Country Club where she had served on the Board of Governors. She loved to play golf and bridge. Mrs. Coulby is survived by three grandchildren, Steffeny Tremain and her husband Allen, Jeffrey G. Smith and his wife Lynn, and Mary Lindsay Riehl and her husband, Pickett; four great-grandchildren; a brother, Guy H. Putman, Jr. of Norfolk, VA and her son-in-law, N. Steffens Smith of Easton.
