Mary Rossbach Klepper, former teacher for Queen Anne's County Schools, died February 2, 2004 at her home in Stevensville. She was 65.

Born in Baltimore City, Mrs. Klepper attended St. Bernard's Elementary School, the Institute of Notre Dame and Towson State and the Johns Hopkins University. After working at Mercantile Bank & Trust, she taught at the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the House of Good Shepherd in Baltimore. In 1966, she moved to Queen Anne's County to teach at South County Elementary School and then at Stevensville Middle School.

Married to fellow school teacher, Virgil R. Klepper, in 1968, Mrs. Klepper continued teaching for another year until the birth of her first child in 1969.

A member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church, she served on the Alter Society for many years. She also worked with her husband in his newspaper distributorship for The Washington Post for 25 years. An avid Baltimore Orioles fan, she kept meticulous records of all games and the players' statistics in her scorebooks.

Mrs. Klepper is survived by her husband, Virgil Sr.; four children, Mary C. Klepper of Cockeysville, MD, Virgil R. Klepper, Jr of Centreville, Christina M.

Morazes of California, MD and Regina M. Klepper of Ocean City, MD; one grandson, Chase R. Klepper of Centreville; two brothers, Paul T. Rossbach of Sterling VA and Francis X. Rossbach of Burlington, CT. A brother, Edgar A. Rossbach preceded her in death in 1977.
