



## Mary T. Stewart

Mary T. Stewart, of Easton, died at her home in Easton on Saturday, April 21, 2001. She was 85.

Born in Sedalia, MO, September 2, 1915, she was the daughter of the late George and Mary Norlin Trader. As a child, she moved with her family to Kensington, MD where she graduated from Central High School in Washington, D. C. After graduating from the Wilson Teachers College, she taught briefly. During World War 11, she worked for the U. S. Government in Washington, D.C. In 1956, she married James Spencer Dyott, a Talbot County businessman, and they made their home in Easton where he died in 1966. Following his death, she worked for the Memorial Hospital at Easton and then for the Talbot County Dept. of Social Services as a caseworker until retiring in 1977.

A charter member of The Presbyterian Church of Easton, she was a member of the Perry Benson Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution and the Edge Creek Boat Club. She had also been a member of the Talbot Country Club, The Talbot County Historical Society, the Academy of the Arts and the Junior Auxiliary of Memorial Hospital of which she was a Past-President.

Mrs. Stewart is survived by her husband, Edward H. Stewart, whom she

married in 1968; a daughter, Lynne Dyott Zerbe of Mechanicsburg, Pa; three step-children, Jane A. Stewart and Patricia A. Brown, both of Ft. Lauderdale, FL and Edward H. Stewart, Jr. of Baltimore; eight grandchildren, Michael J. Zerbe, Bryan S. Zerbe, Mark D. Zerbe, Christa S. Zerbe, Owen Stewart, Tristan Stewart, Megan Stewart and Stephanie Sanchez and three great-grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held on Wednesday April 25th, at Noon at the Presbyterian Church of Easton. Private burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton.
