January 27, 1922 - July 19, 2011

Mary Tucker Mullikin of Centreville, MD passed at her home on Tuesday, July 19, 2011 surrounded by her loving family. She was 89 years old.

Born on January 27, 1922 in Chestertown, MD, she was the daughter of the late, Arthur Morgan Lusby and Mary Tucker Sutton.

As a child she was a member of Shrewsbury Episcopal Church near Kennedyville, MD. She later joined St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Centreville, MD where she taught Sunday School. She was a 4-H club member as a youth and was honored to be selected as one of two ALL STARS from Maryland to attend the National Convention in 1940.
