



## Mary Warner Thomas

January 8, 1933 - August 20, 2009

Mary Warner Thomas of Neavitt, MD, died August 20, 2009 at her home. She was 76.

Born January 8, 1933, in Baltimore, she was the daughter of the late Donald Gray and Mary Valliant Warner.

She retired in 1989 as general manager of the Maryland Horse Breeders Association after serving that company for 24 years. Previously she had worked for the Maryland State Roads Commission and The Johns Hopkins University. Upon her retirement, Mrs. Thomas and her husband moved to Neavitt, near St. Michaels, the home of her mother's family.

In 1966 she was employed as secretary of Christ Church, St. Michaels, retiring in February 2005. She was a member of the Christ Church Altar Guild, Docent's Guild, St. Michaels Museum at St. Mary's Square, and The Upper Shore Genealogical Society.

Mrs. Thomas is survived by two sons, Thomas Clayland Turnbull of Baltimore, and Edwin Steuart Turnbull, Jr., of Stewartstown, PA; one daughter, Donna Valliant Turnbull Kurtinecz of Stewartstown, PA; two stepdaughters, Miriam Thomas Brandau of Baltimore, and Ellen Thomas of Annapolis, six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by

her husband, James B. Thomas in 1997, and her brother Donald G. Warner in 2000.

A memorial service will be held Monday, August 24, 2009 at 11:00 a.m. at Christ Church, St. Michaels, MD.
