



## Matthew Evan Eastman

August 3, 1992 - July 16, 2015

Matthew Evan Eastman of Centreville, MD died on July 16, 2015. He was 22.

Born in Annapolis, MD on August 3, 1992, he was the son of Paul Gunther, Jr. and Karen Gunther. Matthew's birth father was Ed Sinclair. Matthew graduated from Queen Anne's County High School, where he played soccer, basketball, baseball and tennis. After graduation, he enjoyed co-ed softball with his mom and dad, and he played adult flag football. He was currently working at the Under Armour outlet in Queenstown, MD, having previously worked at Olympia Sports on Kent Island

In addition to his parents, he is survived by his step-father, Paul Gunther, Jr.; his brother and sisters: P.J.
