Maureen Breckenridge Roloson (nee Frances Maureen Breckenridge Roloson), loving wife of Willard G. Roloson and sister of Davis T. Breckenridge, passed away quietly on 16 February 2010 after a short illness. She leaves behind a son, Ross T. Roloson, a daughter-in-law, CarolAnn F. Roloson and two grandchildren, Julie and Cory. Maureen was the daughter of Francis Gibson Breckenridge and Sarah Jane Bell Breckenridge. She was born in Hampton, VA on 17 February 1931, and lived in New York, Pennsylvania and a short time with relatives on Islandmagee, Ireland, where her mother was born.

Maureen spent her high school years in Gloucester City, NJ and moved to Baltimore after graduating in 1948. She worked for several years with C & P Telephone Company and Hutzlers in Baltimore. Maureen and Will were married at the Third Lutheran Church in Waverly, MD on 8 September 1951. They moved to "The Barn" on Kent Island, MD in 1965 and enjoyed many sunsets over Cox Creek. Maureen and Will had 37 wonderful years together before Will's passing in 1988, and she was a devoted mother and homemaker.

She was a gifted painter and seamstress who made many of her own clothes, and made dresses for her granddaughter when Julie was young. She enjoyed both Julie and Cory's sporting events, and loved spending time and playing
