Maurice (Marty) Randolph O'Connor, 78 of Chester, MD, passed away peacefully at his home on August 1, 2016.

Born at home in Washington, DC, on May 24, 1938, Marty was the son of the late Robert Milton O'Connor and Alice Mae O'Connor. Marty is preceded in death by his three brothers, Robert M.
