August 22, 1947 - June 15, 2010

Maurice "Mac" Coleman Bowles, III of Grasonville, MD passed away at his home, surrounded by his beloved family, on June 15, 2010. He was 62.

Born on August 22, 1947, he was the son of the late, Maurice Coleman Bowles, Jr. and Faye Burnette and the step-son of Roland Walker. He grew up in Glen Burnie, MD and was a graduate of Andover High School Class of 1965. Mac enlisted in the Air Force in 1966, where he served for 4 years. Mac met his wife, Wendy Hofmann prior to entering the service and they were married on November 2, 1968. Mac and Wendy raised their family in the Annapolis area. After their children were grown, they moved to their waterfront "dream home" on Maryland's Eastern Shore in 2002. Mac was a Software Engineer who worked for NSA/ Department of Defense and retired after 32 years. Upon retiring from NSA he worked for the Computer Science Corporation until this past October. Mac was raised on the "Rivah" and was a true waterman at heart, enjoying fishing, crabbing, boating and all facets of the water.

He is survived by his beloved wife, Wendy Bowles of Grasonville, MD; two daughters, Pamela Bowles Ackermann and husband, Joel and Cheri Diane Sweet and husband, Steve, both of Stevensville, MD; a son, Brian Coleman Bowles and wife, Renee, of Cleveland, OH; sisters, Beverley Faye Walker and Brenda Diane Speer and grandchildren, Amanda, Stephen, Cadi, Braden,

Joseph, Bethani, Joshua, Bailey and Evylina.

A casual memorial service will be held on the beach at Mac's home at 1016 Chester River Drive in Grasonville, MD 21638 on Friday June 18th, 2010 at noon.

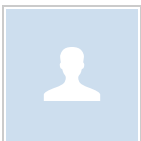

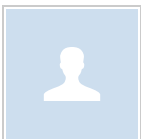
