April 5, 1930 - March 1, 2020

Maxine Eleanor Larrimore of Chestertown, MD, passed away Sunday, March 1, 2020, in Compass Regional Hospice in Chestertown. She was 89.

Maxine was born April 5, 1930, in Wilmington, DE, the daughter of the late Max Benson and Gladys Boyer Benson. She was a 1948 graduate of P.S. Dupont High School in Wilmington, DE. Maxine worked for the Kent County Department of Social Services and retired in 1990. She was a member of the Ladies of the Moose Grasonville Lodge, the Ladies Auxiliary of the Frank Jarmon American Legion Post 36, Rock Hall United Methodist Church, and served in several capacities on the Board of the Maryland Classified Employees Association. 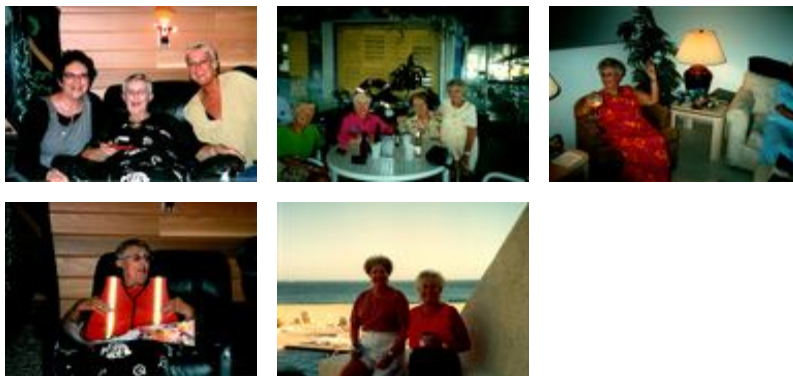
