



Maxine Younger

August 7, 1929 - October 14, 2017

Delores “Maxine” Younger of Rock Hall, MD, died on Saturday, October 14, 2017, at University of Maryland Shore Medial Center at Chestertown. She was 88.

Born on August 7, 1929, in Martin’s Ferry, OH, she was the daughter of the late George A. and Harriet Ann Fairbairn Jones. She was preceded in death by her husband, James M. Younger, and her son and daughter-in- law, Dana M. Jones and Gloria A. Jones. Maxine was the 11th of 12 children and is predeceased by her siblings, Vesta Hayne, Alfred Jones, Russell Jones, Mary Bennett, Gene Jones, Harriet Moc, Mildred Cushing, Vernon Jones, Martha Carpenter, and Vera Harris.

Maxine enjoyed her family and friends, hosting many parties at her home on the creek. Maxine also enjoyed cruises, including a 90-day cruise, where she

was able to visit Africa - where she enjoyed a sunrise balloon ride over the Savannah, India – where she visited the Taj Mahal and China where she climbed on the Great Wall. She visited Paris, England, Sicily, and camped with her son and his family throughout Europe.

She was Queen Mook of her Red Hat Society group – which brought her much joy.

She loved her home on the creek and watching the beautiful sunset every night, and feeding the fish and waterfowl living on the creek. Maxine loved her grandchildren and great-grandchildren, who brought her great joy. She often said how lucky she was to have grown up during the depression and to have lived such a wonderful life. She made all of the lives she touched better for knowing her.

Services will be held on Thursday, October 19, 2017, at 1 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Chestertown, MD, where relatives and friends may call from 12 p.m. – 1 p.m. Interment will be in Crumpton Cemetery following the service. 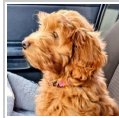

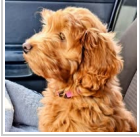

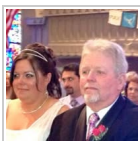
