Maynard Pressley White of Queenstown, MD, died Saturday June 22, 2002, at Memorial Hospital in Easton. He was 69.

Born March 4, 1933, in Ardmore, OK, Mr. White was the son of the late Maynard Pressley White, Sr., and Ruth Lavers. He received his Bachelors of Arts degree in 1955 from Brown University. After graduation, he then enlisted in the United States Army and served in Italy. After being honorably discharged, Mr. White went to University of Delaware where he received a Masters degree and his PHD in History. While attending the University he began his career as a professor in history.

On September 4, 1959, he married Kathleen Brackett of Chestertown, MD. In 1990, they moved together to Queenstown, MD. Mr. White retired from the University in 1998. He was a proud member of Phi Gamma Delta fraternity and enjoyed studying early photography and American history.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by one son, Maynard "Chip" P. White, III, of Atlanta, GA, and one daughter, April White of Queenstown, MD.
