Melville Leaf Wolfe of Chestertown, Maryland died on February 27, 2008 at Chester River Manor in Chestertown. He was 92.

He was born on November 25, 1915 in Govans, Baltimore City, MD the son of the late, Smallwood Leaf and Pearle Casson Wolfe. Mr. Wolfe was educated in Baltimore County and was a graduate of Baltimore Business College. He served his country as a Lieutenant in the U.S. Navy Reserves during WWII and in Japan during the Korean War. He was honorably discharged in March of 1952. Mr. Wolfe worked in the Shipping Industry in Baltimore and with the Maritime Commission in Washington D.C. as an Assistant to the Manager of Marine Operations at the War Shipping Administration for several years.

He was an active Boy Scout and Cub Scout Leader and was also active in the Masonic Orders, receiving the York Cross of Honor. Mr. Wolfe was a charter member of Presbyterian Church of Chestertown where he served as Deacon and was a Founding Member. He was also a member and Past Commander of the American Legion Post #192.

He is survived by his beloved wife, Jane; a daughter, Lanetta "Lanny" Parks of Chestertown, MD; a son, James Melville Wolfe of Smyrna, DE; five grandchildren, two great grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a sister and two brothers.

Services will be held on Saturday, March 8, 2008 at 11:00 A.M. at the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown. A private interment service will be held in Old St. Paul's Church Cemetery.
