Melvin Lee Dunn of Stevensville, MD, died Thursday, November 27, 2014, at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 90.

Born in Liberal, KS, on April 30, 1924, he was the son of the late Harrison Lewis and Milla Catherine Rheuby Dunn.

Mel went to Homedale High with his sweetheart, Alta. Before he enlisted, he attended ammunition advisors school. He then served in the Army Air Corps in the Pacific Theater during WWII. An Iwo Jima survivor, he was a gunner/navigator on the Black Widow night fighter P61. After an honorable discharge, he served the Federal Government as an Ammunition Advisor and a member of the Armed Services Explosive Safety Board until retirement. Hobbies included photography, flying, woodworking and fishing. His greatest joy was his family.

Mr. Dunn is survived by his loving wife of 72 years, Alta Dunn of Stevensville, MD; children, Linda Meyer and her husband Richard of Highland, CA, and Karen Jordan and her husband Bob of Gambrills, MD; seven grandchildren, Will, Richard, Rob, Kristen, James, Scott and Steve; seven great-grandchildren and eight great-great grandchildren; sisters, Glenice Atkins of OR, Loretta McGlaughlin of WA, and Charlotte Tuttle of ID; and a brother, Chuck Dunn of ID.
