



## Melvin ODell Manley

October 25, 1939 - May 4, 2014

Melvin Odell Manley of Millington, MD, died May 4, 2014, at his residence surrounded by family. He was 74.

Mr. Manley was born October 25, 1939, in Lexington, VA, the son of the late Ernest Manley and Mary "Lipscomb" Manley. Mr. Manley was a 1958 graduate of Chestertown High School. He went to work for Lester Smith on a farm for a few years out of high school before being drafted in the United States Army where he served his country and was honorably discharged in 1965.
