Melvin C. Corbett, Jr died on Monday, November 17, 2008 at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 80 years old.

Born on November 30, 1927 in Stamford, CT to the late Melvin Chittenden Corbett and Dorothy Skinner Corbett, Mel grew up in Darien, CT. He served in the Army post-WWII, after being honorably discharged he began working in New York City with American Airlines where he would meet his wife, Nancy Aitken Corbett, whom he married in 1953. They moved to Albany, NY in 1967 while he continued to work for American Airlines where he retired in 1984 as Airport Supervisor at Albany Airport. Then in 1985 they moved to Grasonville, MD. Mel served in the Coast Guard Auxiliary and was very active in the VFW Post 7464 where he served as Assistant Quartermaster for over 15 years.

Mel is survived by his loving wife, Nancy Corbett of Grasonville, MD; 2 sons, Melvin C. Corbett, III of Briarcliff Manor, NY and Todd B. Corbett of Schodack, NY; 2 brothers, W. Sturgis Corbett and Peter H. Corbett both of Stuart, FL; and 2 grandchildren, Corey J. Corbett and Nicole E. Corbett.
