Melvin Richard Crew of Chestertown, Maryland died on October 27, 2007 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, Maryland. He was 71.

He was born at home on February 20, 1936 in Langford, Chestertown, MD, son of the late, Marion "Singapore" and Marguerite Taylor Crew.

He was a 1955 graduate of Chestertown High School and soon enlisted in the U.S. Army where he served as a paratrooper with the 101st Airborne until his honorable discharge in 1963.
