Mercedes Lesser died on March 13, 2011. She was 79 years old.

Born in Santa Cruz, Bolivia on November 30, 1931, she was the daughter of the late, Guillermo and Mercedes Bauer. After attending the German Private School in La Paz, Bolivia, she earned her Bachelor of Science degree in 1954 from the University of Chile. After moving to the United States, she enrolled at the University of Maryland, where she earned a Master's Degree in 1971. In 1977, Mrs. Lesser earned her Doctorate degree from Walden University. Mrs. Lesser worked as a Physical Education Instructor at the German School in La Paz from 1954 until 1956, then at Cambridge Senior High School from 1965 until 1967. In 1968, she became part of the Chesapeake College faculty, retiring as a Professor of Physical Education, Fitness and Wellness in 1998.

She is survived by her loving husband, Kunz Lesser, whom she married on December 31, 1953; her children, Monica Elisabeth Brooks and Jan Conrad Lesser; her grandchildren, Ryan Scott Lesser and Eric Brett Lesser; and her siblings: Rosmarie Bauer, Bernardo Bauer, Nicolas Bauer and Peter Bauer.
