Merrill Francis Cohan of Chester, MD, died Friday, April 1, 2005, at his residence. He was 80 years old.

Born on January 24, 1925, in Lowell, MA, he was the son of the late Merrill and Margaret Cohan. He attended school in Massachusetts. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy during World War II and after being honorably discharged he moved to the District of Columbia and began a career as a district Firefighter serving for 25 years.

He married Evelyn Louise Detlefs Gordon on November 9, 1968, and they made their home in Kent Island where Mr. Cohan resided for over 30 years. During his retirement, he drove a school bus for Queen Anne's County Schools for 10 years.

He was a member of the American Legion for 40 years and was an active member of American Legion Post 278 in Stevensville. He also was a member of the VFW Post 7464 and was active with the Kent Island Senior Center.

Mr. Cohan is survived by two children, Triva Cohan & Bud Cohan, both of Arizona; a stepson, Robert Gordon, Sr., of Ft. Washington, MD; a stepdaughter, Carol McDaniel of LaPlata, MD; seven grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. His wife, Evelyn, died in 2000; and a son, Merrill,

predeceased him.
