



Dr. Michael Marvin Forney

October 17, 1941 - December 31, 2014

Dr. Michael Marvin Forney, husband, father, veterinarian, veteran, outdoorsman, world traveler and philanthropist, passed away peacefully on New Year's Eve - Dec. 31 - at age 73. He died from complications related to pancreatic cancer.

Dr. Forney drew his last breath in a room looking over Urieville Lake, near Kennedyville, Maryland, where he lived for more than 30 years.

He would often say that he drew his essential philosophy toward life from the characters in French novelist Voltaire's "Candide" who prescribed working with others on meaningful projects as a satisfying form of love. "Cultivate your garden," Dr. Mike would say, and he did that right up to the end of his life, most notably as a veterinarian for 45 years in his beloved Kent County, Queen Anne's County and surrounding Eastern Shore counties of Maryland. That work also took him as far afield as Ecuador in South America. There - for 10 years - Dr. Forney served as a consulting veterinarian for the Bustamante family who, while serving at the highest levels of their nation's government, also purchased a herd of Holstein cattle from Kent County. The veterinarian accompanied the herd on their flight south and remembered landing in Miami to oversee the milking of the herd before the journey resumed.

In his final weeks of life, Dr. Forney performed surgeries and cared for the animals for whom he had a special affinity, traveled to Central and South America to pursue his lifelong passion for hunting and fishing, spent time with his family, colleagues and friends, and enjoyed the wildlife that surrounded his

home.

Knowing his time was limited; he gathered his family together before Christmas and used the opportunity to discuss the highlights of his life. He spoke of lessons from his father, Robert Forney, who taught him about respect, business, trusting others and the value of a kind word and a smile. Dr. Forney took particular pleasure in bringing smiles and laughter through the endless telling of jokes and stories.

He talked fondly of his 20-year marriage with Kirsten, his children, his brothers and sisters, growing up on the Chester River and being a part of his community. He also talked of his respect and admiration for his business partner at Chestertown Animal Hospital, Dr. Ralph Buckel, with whom he worked for 45 years, and all of his work associates in his veterinary practice. And he spoke of his clients: "Such a special reward I have been given to have such a group of friends as my clients. We have laughed and cried together over these many years."

Among his joys, Dr. Forney counted his world travel to more than 60 countries. He credited his military service in the Air Force - particularly as a weather specialist stationed in Seoul, Korea - for awakening his thirst for travel. He was most grateful for the GI bill that enabled him to earn an undergraduate degree at the University of Maryland and a veterinary degree at University of Georgia. Closer to home, he counted as a joy his Big Woods Farm. "I have always loved hunting, fishing and crabbing - enjoying the things I had around me," he said. His Bolivian family, who he adopted and supported, were also a source of joy.

"I have had many blessings," he said.

Dr. Forney was born in Detroit, Michigan to Robert Lankford Forney and Elizabeth Marvin Forney on Oct. 17, 1941. His father had moved there to teach school before returning with his family to the Eastern Shore, and Chestertown, in 1953. He graduated from Chestertown High School in 1958 and immediately joined the Air Force, heading off to Lackland Air Force Base in Texas for basic training. He returned to Chestertown after a four-year stint

and then set out on his education and lifelong career. He always valued community service and through the years served as a president for the Chestertown Rotary Club and as a director for Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital.

Dr. Forney is survived by his wife, Kirsten, and his children: a daughter, Laura Michelle Forney and her husband, Ron Sadler, of Gettysburg, Pa.; and two sons, Kyle Forney and his wife, Rhonda, of Gaithersburg, Md. and Rob Forney and his wife, Lisa, of Germantown, Md. He is also survived by a stepdaughter, Michelle Timmons, and her husband, Trey Timmons, of Worton. His grandchildren include Emma Forney-Dillman of Gettysburg, Pa.; Kaitlyn and Riley Forney of Gaithersburg, Md.; Athena and Nathaniel Forney of Germantown, Md.; and Ryan and Nick Timmons of Worton.

He is also survived by four brothers and sisters: Geraldine Hadaway of Rehoboth Beach, Del.; Dennis Forney and his wife, Becky, of Lewes, Del.; Mary Paterson, and her husband, Pat, of Wilmington, North Carolina; and Dr. Raymond Forney of Newark, Del.; and a stepsister, Meg Gulbrandsen and her husband, Leif, of Fairlee, Md.

A memorial service for Dr. Forney has been planned and will be held on Sunday, March 15, 2015 at 2:00 pm in the Chesapeake Room at Rock Hall Vol. Fire Co.

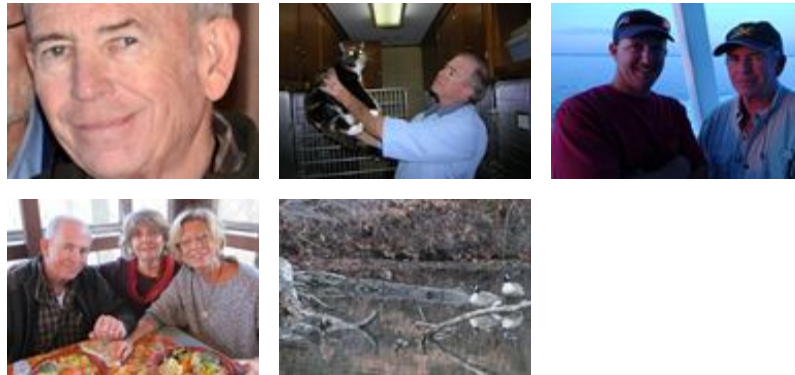

“ Dr. Forney...what an amazing man.

Many years ago, we had a cat that got his leg caught in the fork of tree, and after twisting himself around trying to get loose, he managed to rip apart all of the ligaments on one of his back legs. That cat was in severe pain, and after arriving at the vet, the first vet said the leg could be amputated, or the other option was a costly surgery. Neither option was practical, and the third option of putting him down seemed too unfair to think about. Things looked dire. But before exercising option three, we asked for a second opinion.

In comes Dr. Forney. With that easy going, no nonsense approach, he started looking things over.

"You know, I've seen an injury like this before" he said. "And I believe with a proper wrap, we can have this cat in good shape. He'll need some care along the way, but how about you let me try this, I think I can make it work, and let's see where it goes. His leg will be wrapped up for four weeks, but some ligaments will heal themselves, even when ripped. Come back tomorrow, and pick him up."

His confidence, and his down to earth manner was all we needed to know everything would work out. And it did.

I was fortunate enough to cross paths with Dr. Forney on other occasions as well. A true gentleman in every respect. He'll be deeply missed.

“ Mike Forney, 'got' his patients, both animal and human. He took their measure. He looked after my dogs for decades. I saw him for the last time sometime I think in October with our German shepherd. After the canine exam, we talked about gardening, hunting and a host of his other interests and commitments.

I counted on him -- and he quietly came through -- when I had to put down two of my dogs. For the first one, he came out to the car and gave my 16-year-old Malamute/wolf her final shot and said, much more for our benefit than for the dog's because he knew the decision to do this had been agonizing: "Oh, Lady, it's way past your time!" which helped both me and my husband hugely. Then, he quietly put a hand on my shoulder and left us, which was just what I wanted. Some years later, I asked him to send up a vet (turned out to be Dr. Tim Mears, who couldn't have been sweeter or better for the situation) to put down our cancer-ridden labrador in our back yard so she wouldn't be scared during the last moments of her life. Mike had diagnosed her with inoperable bowel cancer several months before, but she was so happy to be alive (and was such a cuddler) that I figured if she's happy, I am too. I'll do whatever I need to do for her. But after months of cooking all her meals (along with the other dogs') and getting up with her every two hours all night long to take her out, I couldn't do it any more. When I called to make the final appointment, he came on the line. I asked if it was too soon (blubbing) to do this. He listened and then listed -- blessedly calmly -- his three main criteria for euthanizing the dog we called 'the bad puppy' -- 'all of which you fit,' he said -- and finished with, "You went the extra distance". A way of saying I didn't need to feel guilty. No fanfare, no 'Oh, you poor thing!' just quiet comfort in a kind of 'just the facts m'am' kinda way. I'll miss him tremendously.
