December 14, 1924 - November 4, 2017

Michael Andrew Marshall, 30-year resident of Centreville, MD, died on Saturday, November 4, 2017, at his son's home in Durango, CO. He was 92.

Born on December 14, 1924, in England, he was the son of the late William Brown and Dorothy Jessie Collicott Marshall. In 1944-45, he served in the British Army, as a Captain in the 12th Lancers Armored Division. On January 30, 1954, he married Helen (Betty) Humphries in Toronto, Canada, and in 1955, they moved to England. They resided in England until 1977, when they moved to New Jersey upon Michael's appointment to President of Engelhard Industries. Michael and Betty retired to live on Riverview Farm in Queen Anne's County overlooking the Chester River until moving to Heron Point. After his wife's passing in 2016, he moved to Durango, CO, to live with his son.

The family was involved with The Gunston School, Chesapeake Bank and Trust, and Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital.

Mr. Marshall is survived by three sons, David (Melody) Marshall of Phoenix, MD, Peter (Lisa) Marshall of Durango, CO, and Andrew (Cindy) Marshall of Malvern, PA; eight grandchildren; and one great-grandchild.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, November 10, at 2:00 PM, at St.

Luke's Episcopal Church in Church Hill, MD, where interment will follow in the churchyard.
