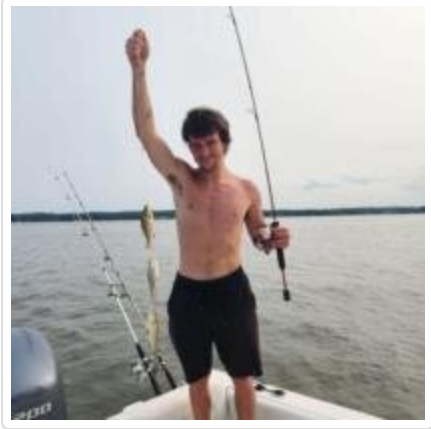




Michael Joseph Parks
