Dr. Michael David Schauber, Sr., of Oxford, Maryland died Saturday, January 21, 2012. Mike was 53. He lived an extraordinary life and was a devoted husband and father.

Mike was born October 13, 1958; he was the son of Adam B. Schauber and the late Shirley M. Schauber.

Following graduation from Easton High School in 1977, Mike attended the United States Air Force Academy. After his freshman cadet year, he left the Academy to pursue academic studies at the University of Maryland and his dream to become a physician. He was a 1981 Cum Laude graduate of the University of Maryland where he earned his B.S. in Microbiology. Mike then attended the University of Maryland School of Medicine where he graduated in 1985 and was commissioned as a Captain in the United States Air Force. Mike was a member of numerous academic and professional honorary societies. He eventually became a board certified Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgeon and performed thousands of surgeries saving numerous lives.

Dr. Schauber was married to the love of his life, Eileen Siemer, of Oxford, Maryland on May 25, 1985. They enjoyed sixteen wonderful years together before his beloved Eileen passed away on December 6, 2002. Mike is survived by their two children, Jennifer M. Schauber of Orlando Florida, and Michael D. Schauber, Jr. of Oxford, Maryland; his father, Adam B. Schauber of Nokomis, Florida; his sister, Dorothy M. Carroll of Cordova; and his brother, Jon A. Schauber of Germantown, TN. An infant son, Adam Schauber, died

May 16, 1990.

Mike and Eileen moved frequently due to the requirements of his surgical training and military duty assignments. They lived in San Antonio, TX, Chicago, IL, Clovis, NM, Biloxi, MS, St. Louis, IL, Winter Haven, FL, and Frederick, MD, before finally returning home to Oxford, MD, in 2001.

Mike was a competitive athlete and an avid traveler. He held many competitive swimming records, played varsity football at Easton High School, and fenced for the Air Force Academy. He competed in numerous road running races, biathlons and triathlons including the Oxford International Long Distance Triathlon. Mike, Eileen and their children enjoyed traveling and created many wonderful family memories during trips to Disney World, Bermuda, St. John Island, Virgin Gorda Island, the Bahamas, and Hawaii. Mike was honorably discharged on June 30, 1997 as a Lt. Colonel from the United States Air Force. He served on active duty for 12 years. Mike was a veteran of the first Persian Gulf War and was awarded the Kuwait Liberation Medal. During his Air Force career, he was awarded the Meritorious Service medal twice for outstanding leadership and performance of duties.

A celebration of Mike's life will be held at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton Maryland on Saturday, January 28, 2012 at 10:30 a.m. Friends and family are invited and are encouraged to share their favorite memories of Mike.

I went to school with Mike from middle school all through high school. He was always top of the class - smart as a whip - and he knew he wanted to be a doctor even way back then. We played football together too. Mike was a ball of energy. Just looking at him based on size alone one would think, "I can handle this guy".....then he'd proceed to knock the crap out of his opponent. Sharky was also just a happy, happy guy - as one can see in the picture.....joy in the moment. Because his brother Jon married our classmate Karen Smith - and because Jon was in the Navy - in their travels they met my cousin, Tim Curry - a former Marine and later a civilian employee of the federal government. I believe they knew each other in the service - but sure they knew each other in PA where they both lived for some time (Tim's still there). “Mike was a friend, a very good one, from Middle School, High School and the Air Force Academy. We used to eat lunch together at Easton Middle School starting in the 7th grade--I came out of Glenwood Elementary and "Sharky" from White Marsh. "Sharky" took his nickname from a calic on top of his head that was quite visible with his short hair. We were in many of the same classes for the next 6 years and both recieved appointments to the United States Air Force Academy (USAFA) following graduation.

The world is a much poorer place with his passing. I'd lost contact with him many years ago, what with his and my moves around the world in service to the country. Frankly, I was unaware he'd moved back into the Easton greater area.

Sharky and I, flew out to USAFA together about 2 weeks after graduating from Easton High School in mid June of 1977. We arrived together in Colorado Springs the afternoon before we had to report to the Academy. We'd flown from Denver on one of Rocky Mountain Air's Dehaviland Twin Otter's, a small 16-pax twin engine prop short takeoff and landing aircraft whcih was loud bouncy and in retrospect a very fitting way to get there. Mike was set on eating well and at his suggestion we found our way to a top flight steak house, the Antler's, where we dined in unaccoustomed style the night before entering the service. We had to borrow jackets and ties from the hotel to even be seated. Mike's plan was that we'd dine there again after graduating.

That first day was sobering -- we took a van from Colorado Springs to USAFA that morning. It made a circuit of local hotels picking a number of us up. We got out and the upper class cadets they lined us up, barked a few instructions, and marched us up the "Bring Me Men" ramp.

Unfortunately, the Academy changed a policy our freshman year and precluded graduates from gaining acceptance to medical school and attending directly following graduation. Mike agonized

over his decision to leave the Air Force and the Academy but had his heart set on being a doctor and was just unwilling to take a chance that the school would revoke the policy change at some point in the future.

After leaving the Academy Mike and I lost contact. I recall congratulating him at one point when I heard he'd graduated from Medical School but we'd just drifted apart. It is a shame really as we'd shared much in common and were both driven in similar ways. I did try and go back to the Antler's following graduation but unfortunately the restaurant had closed. I last thought of Mike when I was assembling a retirement ceremony invitee list last April -- I can't recall if I couldn't find his address or what but we didn't connect. I wish we'd had because Mike was one of the good guys and will be missed.
